



Check-in/Check-out Procedures

- Temperatures of all individuals (parents and children) will be taken at the door before families are directed to the room for check-in. If anyone in the group has a fever (100.4+) they will not be able to attend camp.
- Please limit the number of people accompanying the child at pick-up and drop-off to one adult
- Drop off and Pick up times will be strictly adhered too. Doors will be locked outside of these hours. Alternate drop-off and pick-up times cannot be accommodated at this time unless there is an emergency.
 - Full Day Camp: at the Children's Discovery Museum
 - Drop off: doors will be open 8:30am – 9:00am
 - Pick up: doors will be open from 3:45pm – 4:30pm
 - ½ Day Camp: on the 4th floor of Uptown Station
 - Drop off: doors will be open 9:00am – 9:15am
 - Pick up: doors will be open from 11:45am – 12:00pm
- Sign in/Sign out
 - Please look for tape marks on floor, placed 6 feet apart outside classrooms. Please maintain social distancing while waiting to sign your child in.
 - Hand sanitizer available for use prior to signing in/out campers
 - Pens will be sanitized in between each sign in/out
 - All campers **MUST** have a mask to wear at all times. Parents should have masks to wear while signing in/out
 - All campers must wash their hands upon arrival to the classrooms

Class procedures

- Each Camper will need to bring the following with them each day
 - A mask
 - Lunch (only full day campers) **Avanti's will not be available this summer**
 - Water bottle (we will not be using water fountains or providing glasses for water)
 - A book (we expect longer transition times than normal and we wish for children to have something to read during these times) No Electronics!
- Each camper will be assigned a table and a tub for the week
 - Tubs will be used for the camper's personal supply set, bags, coats and lunches
 - Each camper will be given scissors, markers, pencil, etc. to use for the entire week
- Campers will eat lunch at their assigned table

Cleaning procedures

- All surfaces will be cleaned prior to each day of camp

- Please see the 21 point checklist our Facilities Maintenance staff adhere to
- Tables will be cleaned prior to and after lunch and snack
- Students will wash hands regularly throughout the day
- Hand sanitizer will be available in each classroom
